H 270 ACEQUIA AND DITCH OFFICERS

April 5, 1995

HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 64

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 270, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would provide for changes in the voting procedures used by acequia and community ditch officers. It is vetoed because the current system is satisfactory and should be left to the local jurisdictions involved.

H 273 ASL IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 143

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 273, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

The legislation would mandate American Sign Language as part of the language curriculum in public schools. It is vetoed because it would be an unfunded mandate. New curricula would need to be established within the local school districts without the benefit of new funding.
