

1995 VETO MESSAGES OF HOUSE BILLS

This legislation, which would only add the term "legislative" to the existing statute regarding New Mexico Military Institute scholarships, is vetoed because it does not make any substantive change to current law.

H 333 HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 68

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 333, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would require the State Highway and Transportation Department to include certain provisions regarding completion dates and imposition of liquidated damages in construction contracts. It is vetoed because it is not necessary to include such contract provisions in statute.

H 343 NATIONAL GUARD REGISTRATION PLATES

HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 145

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 343, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would extend the authorization for special license plates for retirees of the National Guard. This legislation is vetoed because I have signed legislation consolidating all military and special use license plates. It is the policy of this administration to limit the proliferation of special automotive license plates for cost reasons.
