H 715 DITCH FUND DISTRIBUTION

April 5, 1995

HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 71

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 715, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would mandate the method of distribution of monies among member acequias and ditches by a majority vote among ditch associations' boards of directors. It is vetoed because it would dictate how a board must distribute money awarded when it appears that the boards are currently fulfilling that responsibility well under the existing statutes.
